The Sadhana of the Wrathful Pema Traktung

The Wrathful Pema Traktung

This deity practice teaching is from the treasure texts of the Namchak Lineage, of the Nyingma School of Tibetan Buddhism. This precious teaching includes visualization, ritual, religious instruments, and butter sculptures (tormas).

A wrathful form of Guru Rinpoche, Pema Traktung fiercely protects all sentient beings from disease and other forms of suffering. The ferocity of his appearance symbolizes the intensity of his compassion.

In Tibetan Buddhist iconography, the wrathful forms of enlightened beings are often depicted with fierce facial expressions, multiple arms, and sometimes in a ring of flames. *Wrathful* does not mean *angry* or *hateful*, but represents their unmovable commitment to alleviate the suffering of beings.



<u>The Pema Traktung course is open to all Vajrayana</u> practitioners who meet the following requirements:

- Vajrayana experience
- PemaTraktung empowerment
- Ngondro

On June 29-30, Tulku Sang-ngag Rinpoche will bestow the Vajrayana and Pema Traktung empowerments for those who need it.

If you are a Vajrayana practitioner and unsure whether you meet the requirements, please send a summary of your Buddhist practice experience including: 1) previous Vajrayana deity practices; 2) which lineage you received ngondro instruction from and what progress is done; 3) if you have the Vajrayana empowerment, from which Lineage; and 4) if you have the Pema Traktung empowerment, from which lineage. The Pema Traktung teaching is in-person only at the Garden of One Thousand Buddhas in Montana.

Registration for Pema Traktung is handled there for convenience because it is also an extension course in the Shedra program.
